### **PRESS RELEASE**

The *Venice Galleries View* association is pleased to announce the *Venice Gallery Weekend*, to be held on March 21, 22, and 23, 2025. This event will feature a rich program of vernissages, talks, and special events promoted and hosted by the member galleries of the association.

While *Venice Galleries View* has organized, shared and widespread initiative in the past, *Venice Gallery Weekend 2025* marks a new chapter for the association. Since its founding in 2018, *Venice Galleries View* has steadily grown over the years, welcoming new galleries and participating more and more actively, becoming an increasingly active participant in Venice's art system. Today, VGV brings together seventeen research galleries operating in the contemporary art and primary market system. Its mission is to attract international art audiences and to promote the city's cultural life, which extends beyond the physical and temporal boundaries of the Biennale.

Venetian galleries are also relaunching *Gallery Weekend* thanks to new developments that have recently transformed the local scene, such as the arrival of international galleries and new institutions. Indeed, this event reflects a broader moment of renewal for Venice, a city which is not only increasingly attracting visitors and art lovers from around the world, but also drawing new residents who contribute to its culture and economic vitality.

By scheduling this initiative outside the Biennale period, *Venice Gallery Weekend* sends a clear signal: Venice is alive and offers a rich cultural proposal all year round. Beyond its world-renowned institutions foreign institutions, the city is home to a thriving ecosystem of commercial galleries, independent spaces, artist studios, foundations and local authorities. Together, these entities work tirelessly to advance art research and promotion, with perseverance and determination.

*Venice Gallery Weekend* provides an unparalleled opportunity to discover the offerings of the galleries participating in *Venice Galleries View*. Over the course of the three day event, these galleries will host a program of coordinated events featuring exhibitions and opportunities to engage directly with many of the participating artists.
